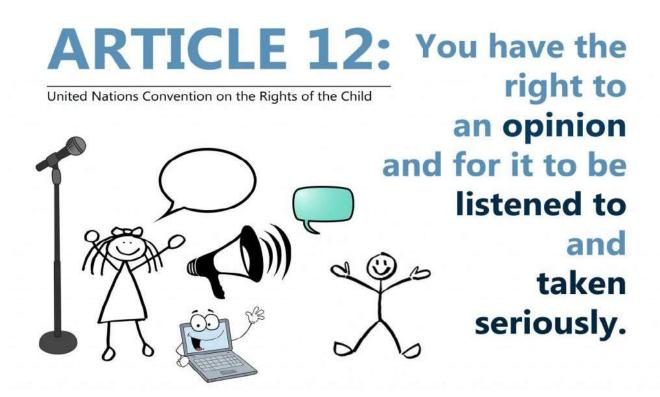

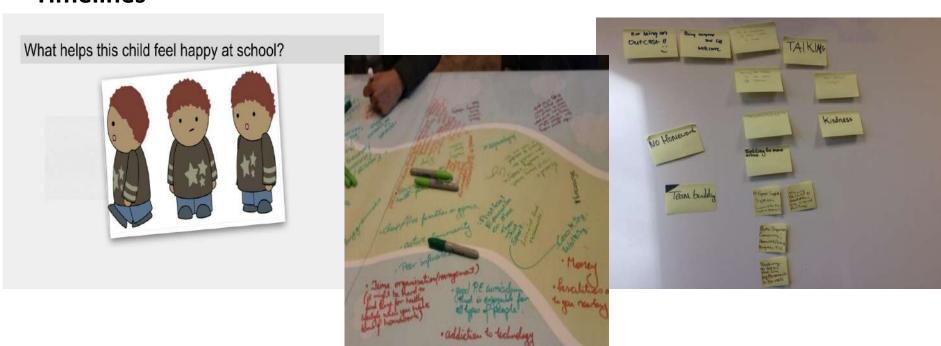

- Experiences of racism

- Sense of identity
- ✓ Language competence
- ✓ Academic achievement

- Acquisition of host language
- ✔ Retention of home language/culture
- ✔ Parent involvement in school
- ✔ Parent acquisition of host language
- Separate anti-racism policy
- School resources for EAL
